<i>Preset - Chroma Light</i>	<i>Removes chroma from areas of the image with high luminance</i>
<i>Preset - Chroma Dark</i>	<i>Removes chroma from areas of the image with low luminance</i>
<i>Preset - Chroma Dark &amp; Light</i>	<i>Removes chroma from areas of the image with low and high luminance</i>
